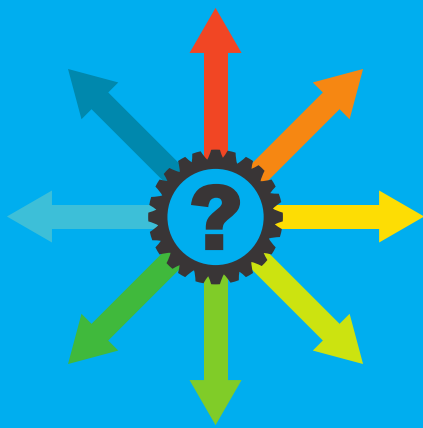


Five facts about MS
